- Perfectly balanced 3 layer construction. The middle layer is laid transversely, with 4mm hardwood top and base layer increasing stability and reducing board swelling and shrinkage by 80%.
- Suitable for use with underfloor heating
- Versatile installation to suit all types of floor construction
- Wide variety of thicknesses, widths and finishes
- Pollutant and allergen free
- A range of care products ensures long term durability
- For historical and visual accuracy Manor House floorboards can be installed in three different widths

Visually,

- The uniform planked surface reflects the warmth, strength and beauty of real wood.
- Admonter Plank flooring is available in a wide variety of appearances and surface finishes - from the raw timber plank (which allows for on-site finishing), to aged; steamed; brushed; smoked; oiled & waxed; oiled & UV cured or a polyurethane finish.
- The precision profiling of boards allows for installation in up to 3 different widths (Manor House floor boards only), giving the floor a more historical and visual accuracy.
- An excellent alternative to solid wood.

Technically,

- Both the upper (decorative) and lower (base) layers are uniquely taken from the same timber species, giving greater flooring stability and strength.
- Surface layer thicknesses of 4mm for hardwood and 5mm for coniferous wood provide excellent wear and durability ensuring your floor looks good for a lot longer.
- Tongued and grooved on every edge the planks are easy and quick to install as either a floating floor, fully glued down or on joists - all with minimum waste.

Ecologically,

- Admonter flooring is sound wood from sustainable forests treated with nature's own wax and oil and has been awarded the IBR seal of quality in terms of health and ecology.

Flexibly,

- The range is available in three widths
- Three thicknesses,
- Vast species range available
- Unfinished, oiled or lacquered.

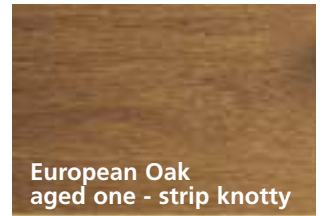

one - strip knotless



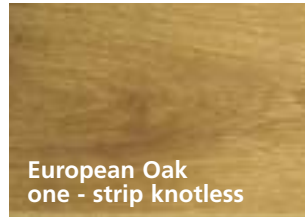

one - strip knotty



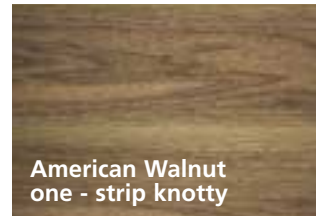
Mountain Larch

All the above options are available in the following sizes:

Thicknesses - 15mm and 21mm, a 10mm option is available for Larch and Oak (1180mm long)

Widths - 158mm, 192mm and 240mm - 240mm available for Mountain Larch and Oak finishes only.

Lengths - Generally 2000mm, 2395mm although can vary so please call for further details. The Mountain Larch, Mountain Larch Aged and Spruce are available to order up to 4870mm long

Finishes - **Unfinished** - smooth sanded board, brushed or double brushed - select and apply your own:
Oiled & Waxed - available in natural or white oil this provides a durable surface, floor pores remain open for future renovation
UV Oil - natural matt appearance, minimum maintenance
Polyurethane acrylic lacquer - pores entirely sealed, highly durable

Save money – eliminate the subfloor

Ideal for areas where you would normally have to fix a base floor before installation, the 21mm thick planks are fully structural and need no support under the end joints when laying, for joist centres up to 600mm. The 21mm product is also ideally suited for glue and screw fixing to uneven timber surfaces or renovations.
